County History: Apache County was originally part of Yavapai County before its establishment in 1879. Originally seen as an “empty” county, a majority of the County’s citizens were members of the Navajo and Apache tribes. Toward the later part of the 1800’s, the total size of the county shrunk from over 20,000 square miles to its current size of 12,000 square miles as territory was lost to Graham and Navajo Counties. Apache County cites itself unique amongst other counties in that it is the longest county in the country, 211 miles from its northern to southern border, as well as its sizable Navajo Nation population. Today, the county is seeing growth due to Arizonans wishing to buy a second home in more rural areas.
