**County History:** Cochise County was originally part of Pima County before its establishment in 1881. The original County seat was in Tombstone, site of the famed Gunfight at the O.K. Corral, before transferring to Bisbee in 1929. The County earned the nickname of the “Land of Legends” due to the number of Western historical figures who have resided there, such as Wyatt Earp and Doc Holliday. Today, the County is site to growing towns and the military base Fort Huachuca.
