**County History:** At its establishment in 1864, Yavapai County was one of Arizona's four original counties. From 1864-1891, Apache, Coconino, Maricopa and Navajo Counties were carved out of the Yavapai, giving it the nickname "Mother of Counties". Its present boundaries were set in 1891, making it one of the larger counties in the nation, being larger in size than some states. Yavapai County is unique in that it has elevations ranging from below 2,000 feet to over 8,000 feet, which allows for both desert and mountain climates.
